ORDINANCE NO. C.S. 1186

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PROHIBITED PARKING ON SISK ROAD

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 11.08.020, subsection 373, of the Stanislaus County Code is amended to read as follows:

“373. Sisk Road. On both sides of Sisk Road from its intersection with Pirrone Road north to the end of the County maintained portion of the road.”

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.

Upon motion of Supervisor Monteith, seconded by Supervisor DeMartini, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, the 7th day of March, 2017, by the following called vote:


