**COMMENDING EMANUEL MEDICAL CENTER'S
2017 CENTENNIAL OF SERVICE TO THE PEOPLE OF TURLOCK AND THE
SURROUNDING AREAS IN STANISLAUS AND MERCED COUNTIES**

WHEREAS, Emanuel Medical Center is celebrating its Centennial of Service on Saturday, June 10, 2017;
and,

WHEREAS, Emanuel Medical Center is the oldest continually operating hospital in the City of Turlock;
and,

WHEREAS, in 1916 the Rev. August G. Delbon and Rev. E.N. Train joined forces with brothers Dr. Albert Julien and Dr. E.A. Julien and gained interest of the Swedish Evangelical Missionary Association for the sponsorship of a new hospital; and,

WHEREAS, 87 individual and business donors raised \$25,000 for a "Hospital to be erected in Turlock...the building is to be constructed of brick, to be built on Canal Drive, one block east of Main Street..."; and,

WHEREAS, the original Emanuel Hospital opened on June 10, 1917 with 34 beds and two operating rooms and expanded and modernized continuously to bring advances in healthcare to Turlock; and,

WHEREAS, the hospital built and opened a new medical campus on Delbon Avenue which opened in 1966 to serve Turlock's growing population; and,

WHEREAS, Emanuel Medical Center brought advanced cancer care to Turlock in 2007 through a partnership with Standford Health Care and the opening of the Emanuel Cancer Center; and,

WHEREAS, Emanuel Medical Center has been a leading community employer, partner and benefactor, dedicated to improving the health and health care for everyone in the greater Turlock area; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors does hereby recognize Emanuel Medical Center's Centennial of Service in appreciation and respect for the wonderful work done by all current and former board members, physicians, staff, and volunteers at Emanuel Medical Center and proclaims its heartiest congratulations and thanks.
