WHEREAS,

May 18th is Law Day in the United States of America; and,

WHEREAS,

The United States of America has been the citadel of individual liberty and a beacon of hope and opportunity for more than 200 years to many millions who have sought our shores; and,

WHEREAS,

The foundation and freedom of liberty is the body of the law that governs us; and,

WHEREAS,

The Constitution of the United States of America and the Bill of Rights are the heart of that body of the law which guarantees us many freedoms, including freedom of religious belief, freedom to have and hold property inviolate, freedom of assembly, freedom of speech, freedom of petition, and due process of the law among other; and,

WHEREAS,

In 2017 we revisit "The 14th Amendment: Transforming American Democracy." As we approach the 150th anniversary of the Fourteenth Amendment, the theme explores how the Citizenship, Due Process and Equal Protection clauses of this transformative amendment served as the cornerstone of landmark civil rights legislation, the foundation for court decisions protecting fundamental rights, and a source of inspiration for all those who advocate for equal justice under law.
