#### SUBJECT:

Approval to Set a Public Hearing on June 27, 2017, at 9:05 a.m., to Consider Adjustments to the Stanislaus County Franchise Maximum Rates for Solid Waste Collection Services

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Set a public hearing for June 27, 2017, at 9:05 a.m., to consider adjustments to Stanislaus County franchise maximum rates for solid waste collection services in Franchise Areas 1, 2, 3 and 4.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The unincorporated portions of Stanislaus County are divided into four separate franchise refuse hauling areas (Franchise Areas), each of which contain a mix of residential, commercial, and drop box customers. These four Franchise Areas contain the following residential communities: Area 1 - Salida, Keyes, Crows Landing, Grayson, and Westley; Area 2 - Knights Ferry and Valley Home; Area 3 - Denair, Empire, Hickman, and La Grange; and Area 4 - the unincorporated areas are primarily pockets within the City of Turlock (Attachment B). In exchange for a franchise fee, the hauler receives the exclusive right to the residential and commercial accounts within their respective area, while Stanislaus County retains the ability to regulate the haulers and set the maximum rates that can be charged. In addition, the Board of Supervisors also sets the franchise maximum haul rates for drop box customers.

On November 4, 2008, the Board adopted a new Refuse Rate Adjustment Process and approved a Baseline for Rates (Base Rates), which set the maximum franchise rates for solid waste collection services in the unincorporated areas of Stanislaus County. The new Base Rate became effective on July 1, 2009. In addition, the Board approved a new methodology for the annual adjustment of these Base Rates. For four consecutive years, beginning with July 1, 2009, the Base Rates may be adjusted according to the appropriate consumer price index (CPI). Every fifth year, a detailed cost of service study will be repeated to determine new Base Rates, followed by another four years of index-based adjustments.

On June 18, 2013, the Board of Supervisors adopted the new Base Rates for solid waste collection services in the unincorporated areas of Stanislaus County. The new Base Rates became effective on July 1, 2013. The upcoming Fiscal Year is the final year of the four consecutive years when Base Rates may be adjusted based on the changes in a series of consumer and other price indices.

The Transfer fee, unlike the other components, is not automatically adjusted with the CPI during the four year cycle. This fee pays for the handling and processing expenses at the transfer stations. The adjustment in this fee is at the discretion of the County. The last time this component was adjusted was in 2014 where a 10% adjustment was considered, but a 5% adjustment was approved. The Department is proposing an 8% increase in this component to offset CPI adjustments over the past several years.

The following indices and their respective changes (i.e., the difference between the April 2015 – March 2016 average, and the April 2016 – March 2017 average) have been applied to the indicated components of the individual companies' residential and commercial Base Rates. Only the labor, fuel, collections, and interest adjustments have been applied to the Drop Box Base Rates because the County sets only the haul charges for these services. Disposal, transfer, and franchise fees are billed to the customer directly by the companies as part of the service charge.

The proposed rates (Attachment A) are presented in a format that identifies the following: the current rates and the rates currently being proposed with the appropriate indices applied; and the net change between the rates customers are currently paying through the end of the fiscal year and the rates proposed for Budget Year 2017-2018.

Upon approval, adjustments will be seen in all solid waste collection service charges in the unincorporated areas of Stanislaus County and will be effective July 1, 2017. Subscribers to residential basic service consisting of 1-90 gallon cart, curbside recycling and bulky item collection may see changes in their monthly service charges ranging from a 2.52% to a 2.93% increase. Proposed commercial bin rate adjustments range from a 2.76% to a 2.98% increase and proposed franchise drop-box haul charge adjustments range from a 1.13% to a 1.17% increase.

#### **POLICY ISSUE:**

The setting of a public hearing by the Board of Supervisors is required prior to adjusting the maximum rates for solid waste collection services.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The net change in estimated revenue for the Franchise Haulers from the proposed rates for the Budget Year 2017-2018 will be approximately \$319,373.39, which will increase County revenue through the 8% franchise fees by approximately \$25,550 and is included in the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Recommended Proposed Budget.

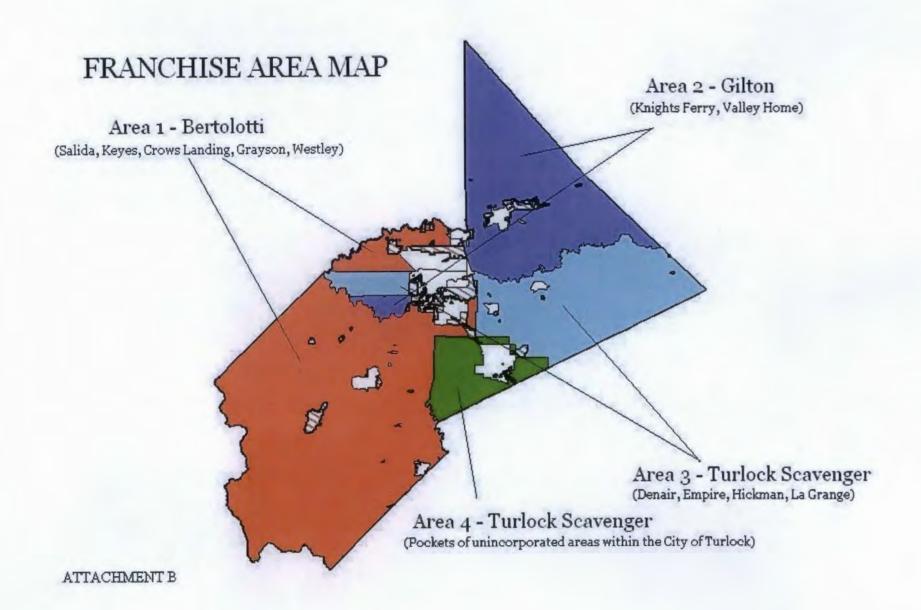
