

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on June 27, 2017, at 9:15 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors will meet in the Basement Chambers, 1010 10th St., Modesto, CA, to consider the introduction, waiving of the reading, and adoption of an ordinance which extends, upon voter approval, the existing one-eighth of one percent Library Transactions and Use Tax for 12 years, commencing on July 1, 2018 until June 30, 2030, for the continued exclusive funding of the Stanislaus County Library System. This ordinance would require Stanislaus County to place the proposed tax on the November 7, 2017 Consolidated District Election (UDEL) Ballot. This tax will be administered by the State Board of Equalization with an independent citizens oversight committee ensuring these funds are spent only on Stanislaus County libraries.
