SUBJECT:

Approval of Agreements for Behavioral Health and Recovery Services for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 for the Provision of Mental Health, Alcohol and Drug, and Ancillary Services

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Approve the agreements with service providers for Behavioral Health and Recovery Services effective July 1, 2017, for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 as reflected in this agenda item.
- 2. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or his designee, to sign the agreements for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 as reflected in this agenda item.
- 3. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or his designee, to negotiate and sign amendments to all agreements discussed in this agenda item, as Attachment A, to add services and payment for services up to \$75,000 per agreement, budget permitting, throughout Fiscal Year 2017-2018.
- 4. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or his designee, to negotiate and sign amendments to all agreements discussed in this agenda item, as Attachment B, to add services and payment for services up to \$25,000 per agreement, budget permitting, throughout Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

DISCUSSION:

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services contracts with numerous individuals and agencies for the provision of mental health, alcohol and other drug, and ancillary services to Stanislaus County residents. In most cases, individuals and agencies are selected through a competitive process, which takes into account specific expertise, as well as cost efficiency. Agreements are renewed based on a demonstrated ability to deliver required outcomes effectively, along with availability of funding. While a number of agencies have successful, long-term partnering relationships with Behavioral Health and Recovery Services, all applicable provider agreements will continue to be reviewed and competitive bids will be sought periodically, consistent with Board of Supervisors' direction.

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services experiences occasional funding opportunities and unanticipated increases in the utilization of services throughout the year. On many occasions, this additional funding is time sensitive. For this reason, the Department requests Approval of Agreements for Behavioral Health and Recovery Services for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 for the Provision of Mental Health, Alcohol and Drug, and Ancillary Services

authorization for the Behavioral Health Director, or his designee, to negotiate and execute amendments, when necessary, up to \$75,000 to the agreements listed in Attachment A of this agenda item without further action by the Board of Supervisors, throughout Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

Attachment A includes those agreements that have a cumulative value that exceeds \$100,000, for the period beginning July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2018, as required in Contract Reporting Policy Number One, originally approved by the Board on January 24, 2006, and modified by the Board on March 22, 2011. Any amendments to these agreements will be identified in subsequent quarterly financial reports to the Board of Supervisors.

In addition, County departments are required to provide a quarterly report to the Board of Supervisors for any agreement wherein the compensation exceeds \$50,000 but does not exceed \$100,000, and the contract has not been previously approved by the Board of Supervisors. Attachment B identifies these agreements.

The Department requests authorization for the Behavioral Health Director, or his designee, to negotiate and execute amendments, when necessary, up to \$25,000 to all agreements listed in Attachment B of this agenda item without further action by the Board of Supervisors, throughout Fiscal Year 2017-2018. Any amendments to these agreements will be identified in subsequent quarterly financial reports to the Board of Supervisors.

The total amount of contracts over \$100,000 cumulatively, to be approved by the Board of Supervisors through this agenda item is \$53,709,229 for Fiscal Year 2017-2018. The total amount of contracts over \$50,000 cumulatively but under \$100,000 over this time period is \$282,312. The total for all proposed agreements is \$53,991,541. It is essential that the agreements in this agenda item be fully executed before July 1, 2017, to avoid disruption of critical services to the residents of Stanislaus County.

POLICY ISSUE:

As noted above, Board of Supervisors approval is required for any contract or agreement where the total cumulative compensation exceeds \$100,000. Cumulative refers to the total compensation paid by an individual department in the reporting year and the two fiscal years immediately prior thereto, where there has been no break in contractual services over six months.

This agenda item is in compliance with this policy. It is also essential that the agreements in this agenda item be fully executed before July 1, 2017, to avoid disruption of critical services to the residents of Stanislaus County.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 includes \$53,991,541 in funding for the agreements identified in Attachment A and Attachment B of this agenda item. Funding for these contracts comes from 11 different revenue sources; 1991 Realignment, Medi-Cal Federal Financial Participation, Mental Health Services Act, 2011 Realignment, inter-departmental agreements, Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment

(SAPT) Block Grants, First 5 Early Childhood (Proposition 10), Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Block Grants, Public Safety Realignment (AB109), Early Headstart, and County General Fund Match. The County General Fund pays for \$59,220 in services associated with the Public Guardian. There is no additional impact to the County General Fund.
