

SUBJECT:

Approval to Adopt Plans and Specifications for the Paving Projects at Fairview Community Park and Woodward and Modesto Reservoir Regional Parks and Set the Bid Opening Date and Time for Wednesday, October 11, 2017, at 2:00 p.m.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Adopt all plans, specifications and working details for the paving projects at Fairview Community Park and Woodward and Modesto Reservoir Regional Parks.
2. Direct the Department of Parks and Recreation to send the "Notice Inviting Bids," electronically and by mail to trade journals and newspaper advertisement as required by law.
3. Authorize the Director of Parks and Recreation, or designee, to oversee the public works of improvements associated with the various paving projects.
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to publish the attached "Invitation to Bidders (contractors)" for the various paving projects as required by law and set the deadline for submission of bids as Wednesday, October 11, 2017, at 2:00 p.m.

DISCUSSION:

The Department of Parks and Recreation (Department) is requesting to adopt plans and specifications and go out to bid for paving projects at Fairview Community Park and Woodward and Modesto Reservoir Regional Parks (Attachment C). These projects will be paid for through grants and deferred maintenance funding and are described, below.

Fairview Park - Area #1: Fairview Park is located near the intersection of Placer and Tucson Avenues in Modesto, California. The Department has received a Housing Related Parks Grant to improve the Park and a portion of these funds will be used to pave the dirt entrance off of Tucson and create an asphalt parking lot including required Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Woodward and Modesto Reservoirs – Area #2 and #6: A Quagga and Zebra Mussel Grant will fund the paving of areas at the reservoir facilities that will provide for the inspection of watercraft vessels. The watercraft vessels are pulled into separate areas and inspected to ensure they are not bringing invasive mussels into the water facilities. The improvements

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include new paving, sealing of an existing parking area, new and/or restriping as required, and would include bringing the areas up to ADA standards.

Woodward Reservoir – Area #7: The Office Point parking area is a heavily used day use area during the peak season of May through September. This parking lot has been in disrepair for many years with large pot holes and little to no striping. The lifejacket loaner station is located in this area and is operated by the Sheriff's STARS volunteers. This project has been approved to use the Plant Acquisition - Deferred Maintenance budget to repave this parking area, stripe the parking lot, and includes bringing it up to ADA standards.

The Department of Parks and Recreation has worked with the Department of Public Works to ensure that all County standards are included in the plans and specifications.

Following the bid opening, staff will return to the Board of Supervisors with a recommendation to award the contract(s) to the lowest acceptable bidder.

Stanislaus County is the lead agency for CEQA and these projects are exempt from California Environmental Quality Act, Class 1, California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §15301 (Existing Facilities) and §15302 (Replace and Reconstruction).

POLICY ISSUE:

California Public Contracting Code sections 20124 and 20125 require that the Board of Supervisors adopt the plans and specifications and cause an advertisement for bids for this Public Construction Contract.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The paving projects are estimated to cost \$355,000. \$280,000 has been appropriated in the Department of Parks and Recreation's Fiscal Year 2017-2018 adopted Proposed Budget and will be paid for through grant funds and \$75,000 will be paid for through the Plant Acquisition - Deferred Maintenance budget.

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BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PRIORITY:

The recommended actions are consistent with the Board's priorities of providing A Well Planned Infrastructure System and the Efficient Delivery of Public Services by upgrading and improving recreational facilities and resources at the regional and community parks.

STAFFING IMPACT:

Existing staff will oversee the work related to the projects.
