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**SUBJECT:**

Approval to Use Community Development Funds for Cleanups in Salida and West Modesto

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

1. Approve the use of \$7,000 of Community Development Funds to pay for community cleanups in Salida and West Modesto.
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller to make the necessary budget adjustments per the attached budget journal.

**DISCUSSION:**

The Stanislaus County Community Development Fund was established by the Board of Supervisors in Fiscal Year 2007-2008, and has funded a variety of one-time projects benefiting the unincorporated area that demonstrate strong local support and a general public benefit.

Over the past several years a local congregation has partnered with a congregation from Oregon to conduct clean-ups around the Modesto area. Cleanups typically included alleys in unincorporated areas of West Modesto and downtown Modesto. This year, the organizers have selected to focus on cleaning alleys in West Modesto.

To assist in maximizing this effort, \$3,500 in Community Development Funds is being requested to reimburse Public Works for two days of assistance from a piece of heavy equipment and one operator. The use of heavy equipment allows for the community group to address more alleys, which suffer from illegal dumping. If approved, the cost of the heavy equipment and operator will be funded from District 3 Community Development Fund balances.

In addition to the West Modesto cleanup, the Department of Environmental Resources, Public Works, and the Sheriff will conduct a one-day cleanup in Salida. The specific area targeted is adjacent to Salida Boulevard and the Union Pacific Railroad between Broadway and Pelendale. The cleanup will include public works loader, operator, truck and bin to haul the debris to the County landfill. An amount of \$3,500 in Community Development funds will be used to pay for the cost of the loader, operator, truck and bin.

**POLICY ISSUE:**

Board of Supervisors approval is required for the use of Community Development Funds.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

If approved, \$7,000 in District 3 Community Development Fund balance will be used to support the alley clean-up. District 3 has a current balance of \$468,529 and the Community Development Fund has a combined balance of \$2,367,727.

**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PRIORITY:**

The recommended actions are consistent with the Board's priority of Supporting Strong and Safe Neighborhoods by supporting a community alley clean-up.

**STAFFING IMPACT:**

The Chief Executive Office oversees the use of community development funds to ensure they are consistent with the proposed project and the Board's direction.
