COMMENDING DR. SILVIA DIEGO ~ STANISLAUS MEDICAL SOCIETY'S RECIPENT OF THE JOHN DARROCH MEMORIAL AWARD

WHEREAS, the Stanislaus Medical Society is proud to present Dr. Silvia Diego with the 2018 John Darroch Memorial Award for Outstanding Physician of the Year. This annual award goes to a physician who stands out for dedication to patient care, education and quality of medicine. The award will be presented to her on Thursday, May 10, 2018 at the Del Rio County Club in Modesto; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Diego will be the first female physician to receive the honor of being Physician of the Year by the Stanislaus Medical Society; and,

WHEREAS, she has been practicing medicine for almost 22 years and currently has her own private practice, Family First Medical Care in Modesto; serving a mix of insured patients and those covered by Medi-Cal and Medicare. She treats her patients like family and offers an array of services including general medicine, prenatal care, women's health and support groups; and,

WHEREAS, after attending CSU Fresno and receiving her degree in Biology, Dr. Diego studied at Stanford University School of Medicine having received her medical degree in 1994; and,

WHEREAS, for 18 years she was a physician with Golden Valley Health Centers serving as Full- time Staff Physician for one year; Clinical Director for 3 years; Associate Medical Director for 4 years; and Chief Medical Officer for 9 years before moving on to open her own practice; and,

WHEREAS, she has a passion for indigent health care and a love for delivering babies; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Silvia Diego is a member of the Latino Physicians of California, whose goal is to encourage more physicians from that ethnic community. The group is working with Kaiser Permanente to develop a pilot program to help Latino college students with applications to medical schools; and,

WHEREAS, she aspires to impact the lives of young people and serve as a role model in their pursuit of higher education and in doing so has passed along her passion and ideals to her own children; her eldest son is a second-year surgery resident at a program in Bakersfield and her daughter is a dental student at UCLA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors does herby commend Dr. Silvia Diego for her outstanding contributions to the citizens of Stanislaus County and congratulates her upon being the 2018 John Darroch Memorial Award recipient.
