#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:**

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

#### DISCUSSION:

It is proposed to change the meeting dates and locations as shown on the attached Schedule. The purpose is two-fold. The first is to comply with the Cooperative Agreement between the NCC TEA and Caltrans that states that Caltrans will have at least ten days to review any information released to the public. The revised schedule reflects appropriate review times and generally provides Caltrans with the ten days requested. In a very few instances, the times are shorter by a few days, however, Caltrans is willing to work to expedite those particular instances. Caltrans' review is important to maintain appropriate California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and National Environmental Protection Act (NEPA) processing of the public record.

The second purpose for revising the schedule is to accommodate the overall environmental schedule. The project has just entered into spring survey activities and the beginning of technical report writing. It is anticipated that during the next two years while these studies and writings are progressing, the information to share with the Board will be best served by presenting every other month, rather than monthly. It is still staff's intent to keep the Board, our stakeholders and the public informed and engaged in the project.
