PRESENTATION: LIFE PATH: Early Psychosis Intervention Program (EPI)

Tiffany Raymond-Rivera, Senior Director, along with her staff provided a PowerPoint presentation highlighting the LIFE Path services offered, specifically psychosis, its experiences, risks, and interventions serving youth ages 14 to 25 years of age. LIFE Path accepts referrals from hospitals, counties, schools, community programs, and offers services under both Medi-Cal and private insurance in addition to aftercare and additional resources as needed. A copy of the PowerPoint was distributed to the members.
