Lisa Mantarro Moore, Executive Director of the Family Justice Center, gave an update on Stanislaus County Services and Outcomes.

Rafi Nazarians, with the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP), shared the County has joined the AARP Network of Age Friendly Communities and presented a certificate to the Board acknowledging the County's new designation.

Miguel Donoso voiced concerns regarding Item 7.2 and requested this agenda item be translated into Spanish and removed from the agenda to be discussed at a future meeting. He thanked Supervisor Withrow for his participation at the King Kennedy Center meeting.
