2. Funds Presentation, discussion, and action regarding the Burbank – Paradise Fire Protection District Impact Fee Study – Final Report.

Jeff Small from Capitol Public Finance Group, LLC presented the Final Report of the Burbank-Paradise Fire Protection District Impact Fee Study via TEAMS to the PFF Committee. Impact fees are based on the current values of all fire equipment and facilities necessary to protect current residents at currents service levels. This fee is translated into a per square foot cost that is imposed on any new construction which may occur. The proposed Impact fee for fire facilities is \$2.02 per square foot of new construction.

3. Presentation, discussion, and action regarding the Stanislaus Consolidated Fire Protection District Impact Fee Study – Final Report

Jeff Small from Capitol Public Finance Group, LLC presented the Final Report of the Stanislaus Consolidated Fire Protection District Impact Fee Study via TEAMS to the PFF Committee. Impact fees are based on the current values of all fire equipment and facilities necessary to protect current residents at currents service levels. This fee is translated into a per square foot cost that is imposed on any new construction which may occur. The proposed Impact fee for fire facilities is \$0.81 per square foot of new construction.

- 4. Consider the request from Sheriff's office to use \$1,265,230 in PFF funds for the Sheriff's Office Training Center Classroom Replacement at Ray Simon Project.
  - Lt. Ryan Maxwell, Brooke Freeman and Teresa Vander Veen from Stanislaus County Sheriff's Dept. requested \$1,265,230 in PFF funds for the Sheriff's Office Training Center Classroom Replacement at Ray Simon Project. This request is to meet the demand for the growing needs of training space. The County purchased temporary modular classrooms, which are now past their useful life. The Sheriff's office is proposing to construct a new permanent classroom facility to accommodate the growth and demand for training. This permanent structure is also better suited to the type of hands-on classes to be taught in the facility, including defensive tactics.

- 5. Consider the request from Sheriff's office to use \$1,485,000 in PFF funds for the Sheriff's Office Minimum Housing Unit Medical and Administration Project.
  - Lt. Ryan Maxwell, Brooke Freeman and Teresa Vander Veen from Stanislaus County Sheriff's Dept. requested \$1,485,000 in PFF funds for the Sheriff's Office Minimum Housing Unit Medical and Administration Project. This request is so medical staff can provide services to the increased number of individuals in custody. Previously these staff were housed in a temporary modular space. Those modulars are now beyond their useful life and staff have been displaced to an inmate program classroom. Contracted medical staff are required to remain in a vicinity to meet a two-minute response time to a medical emergency. With no

other space available, they now occupy a classroom within the MHU-2. The proposed replacement facility will provide a permanent space within the minimum housing secured perimeter for the additional contracted medical staff and programs staff necessary to support the growing population of incarcerated persons.

Dear Public Facility Fee Committee:

Stanislaus Regional Housing Authority (Stan Regional) is seeking to obtain a waiver from the Public Facility Fee Committee for Edwards Estates Phase II Development located at the Northeast corner of Roselle Ave and Bellingham Way in Modesto CA. Edwards Estates Phase II Development will consists of 33 single family homes aimed at first-time homebuyers, priced up to 120% of AMI.

A unique aspect of this project is that the Housing Authority will retain ownership of the land through a land lease, structuring the homes similarly to a condo concept. This approach allows the Housing Authority to offer homes at a more affordable price and maintain the affordability on future sales of the homes.

Stan Regional is seeking the waiver under the Stanislaus County Public Facilities Fee Administration Guidelines, Section D – Exemptions (revised May 11,2021) as follows:

 Public Facilities Fees established by these policies shall not be imposed on any of the following: State and local agencies, utilities, fire district, public schools, public housing agencies, community service districts, etc.

A Public Facilities Fee Waiver will enable Stanislaus Regional to offer affordable home ownership opportunities in Stanislaus County. It is with great hope that the Public Facilities Fee Waiver is approved.
