






Baseline Groundwater Use



GROUNDWATER USE REDUCTON FRAMEWORK



Well Mitigation Program

- Analysis by Todd Groundwater indicates ~85 wells projected to go dry in both GSAs at the currently projected groundwater level declines. Due to data limitations, actual number is not known.
- DWR expects a Well Mitigation Plan to be Developed and Implemented
- Plan to develop and finalize an MOU with WTSGSA outlining plan development approach and attach to the updated GSP
- Actual plan would be developed and adopted late 2024/early 2025
- Draft MOU has been reviewed by staff and legal
